- Sweeney's letter: Letter generated by John Sweeney (R-NY-20) to Chairman Knollenberg (R-MI-9) requesting an increase of 120 AT Supervisors. Trish met Friday with Tony Essalih and Jeff Westmoreland of Congressman Culberson's (R-TX-7) Office. They discussed the NATCA issues within the letter. Others that signed the letter were Hal Rogers (R-KY-5), Kay Granger (R-TX-12), Jim Walsh (R-NY-25), Ernest Istook (R-OK-5), Ralph Regula (R--OH-16), John Carter (R-TX-31), Henry Bonilla (R-TX-23) and Robert Aderholt (R-AL-4). Trish is planning to set up meeting with their offices as well to relay the same sentiment. The goal is to encourage the offices to get the NATCA position on these issues before circulation of future letters.
- **RSC Budget Options 2005**: Christine is making phone calls to inquire about this report. She clarified that this summary is not endorsed by all the members of that committee.
- Grassroots Campaign: Letter drafted to be issued to Congress. Letter was intended to be sent on Wed 9/21 and may be delayed till Wed 9/28. NLC members should continue to encourage NATCA members to sign up on the Grassroots website on the http://www.natca.net website legislative activism or directly at http://www.unionvoice.org/natca/join.html
- **Grassroots Website:** Alex suggested that NATCA include in their Secretary/Treasurer class a section on local's signing up their members on the site.
- NLC Budget and NIW budgets: Both budgets were submitted by Trish on September 15, 2005. We will receive our budget allocations in late November.
- **Training**: Legislative 101 and more advanced classes are proposed to be offered. These types of classes will be developed and offered at the National Office. John suggested having NATCA HQ look into posting legislative classes on the NATCA internet. <u>ACTION by Trish</u>
- Use of PAC Funds: The committee will research and attempt to develop a white paper on use of PAC funds for other than campaign contributions. <u>Action by John.</u>
- **BBS updates**: CC Trish on updates and grassroots activities in the field in order for her to share them with others via grassroots updates.
- Briefing by Christine:
 - Appropriations Bill: House Bill done. Senate Bill still working. There are approximately 33 legislative days left before Thanksgiving. House leadership and chairman may want to run them individually with CR until next year. Senate looking into consolidating Bills
