

## Scholarship Application National Air Traffic Controllers Association

Eligibility: This fund was established for the spouses, children, stepchildren and legally-adopted children of active, retired and deceased NATCA members with continuous membership in good standing of at least two years.

**Awards:** NATCA will administer 20 national scholarships of \$1,000 per year, based on a lottery system administered by the National President. These scholarships are for full-time attendance at accredited colleges and universities within the United States and its territories, in an undergraduate degree program. **Application:** Applicants must apply in writing to the National President, NATCA Scholarship Program, no later than March 1 annually for the college/university attendance within that calendar year with the completed application form and a 500-word essay.

Essay: Complete the essay and enclose it with the completed application. Describe career goals and aspirations. Highlight the importance of the union and the labor movement to your family and/or yourself, and why you are deserving of a union scholarship.
