

**Memorandum of Agreement
Between the
National Air Traffic Controllers Association
and the
Federal Aviation Administration**

This Agreement is made by and between the National Air Traffic Controllers Association, AFL-CIO ("NATCA" or "the Union") and the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA" or "the Agency"), collectively known as "the Parties." This Agreement represents the Parties complete understanding of the Parties concerning the representation of the Engineering Procedures Office (AIR-110) bargaining unit as identified in FLRA Certification Case No. WA-RP-11-0056 (Attached).


Section 1. In accordance with Article 2 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) dated April 7, 2011, between the National Air Traffic Controllers Association Multi-Unit and the Federal Aviation Administration, the CBA is hereby amended to include those employees covered by the Certification of Representative (Case No. WA-RP-11-0056) dated July 2, 2013.

Section 2. Article 11 Section 2a is amended to include AIR-110, Engineering Procedures Office – BUS code 5902, FPPS code 563.




