

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN
THE NATIONAL AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS ASSOCIATION
AND
THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION

This Agreement is made between the National Air Traffic Controllers Association ("NATCA" or "the Union") and the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA" or "the Agency"), collectively known as "the Parties." This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the Parties at the national level concerning all issues regarding Federal Motor Vehicle Registration System ("FMVRS").

1. NATCA will provide a subject matter expert to assist the agency in the development of training. The Parties agree to work collaboratively.
2. Training will be accomplished by in-person or through Video Teleconference (VTC) training, as determined by the Agency, with all personnel responsible for the FMVRS program at the same time.
3. FMVRS shall be made a continuing agenda item on the monthly telecons. In this forum the bargaining unit employees ("BUEs") shall be afforded the opportunity to identify issues with the processes related to FMVRS and assist in the development of resolutions.
4. Should it become necessary to update the JAT for the Fleet Manager position, the Agency will comply with all requirements in accordance with Agency policy and the Parties' collective bargaining agreement..
5. This Agreement does not constitute a waiver of any right guaranteed by law, rule, regulation or contract on behalf of either Party.
