Subject: NOTICE: Position Display Monitors (PDM) Survey

Dear Mr. Rinaldi:

Please see the attached Position Display Monitor (PMD) survey being implemented by the Air Traffic Services (AJT-22). The target audience will consist of ATMs and their Facility Representatives from TRACONS and Combined Tower and Approach Control facilities. The purpose for this survey is to gather information regarding the impact of PDM failure prior to being replaced. The survey will be sent to the ATM with the direction and expectation that the ATM will communicate to his managers to formulate an answer from the management team. The ATM will share the survey with the Facility Rep who will communicate with the BUEs within their facility to formulate an answer from the collective Unit for inclusion in a response to the requestor.

The survey will be conducted on the employee's duty time and will take 5-10 minutes to complete. Participation in survey will be voluntary and content will be anonymous in nature. The requestor from AJT-22 will at no point be aware of whom answered the questions or what an individual answer is, but will only receive responses from 'a facility'. The Union shall be provided a copy of survey results at the same time they are distributed to the corresponding level of the Agency. AJT will implement immediately upon union approval.
