The minutes from the National Executive Board (NEB) meeting in San Diego on Feb. 28-March 1 are now available here on the NEB minutes page of the website.




Safety and Technology Spotlight: TBFM

During the first quarter of 2022, NATCA members were involved with several positive steps for Time-Based Flow Management (TBFM). TBFM is a system of tools used to manage traffic flows based on time to maximize efficiency. Article 114 Rep Matt Gammon (Indianapolis Center, ZID) reports that in February, the TBFM Ops Team participated in Integrated Departure Arrival Capability (IDAC) installations



at Islip (ISP) and Harrisburg (MDT), then returned to Harrisburg a couple of weeks later to conduct IDAC training at the facility. Ops Team members also worked together with MDT and New York Center (ZNY) to discuss operational use of the system, Gammon said. In other program news, the new TBFM 4.10.2 system was released to the field. "The previous system has been in the field for an extended period, and an update was essential," Gammon said. "Additionally, the new 4.10.2 systems added functionality that was requested by the field." Read more.
