Protocol for Positive COVID-19 Tests in Facilities (May 1, 2020)

Brothers and Sisters,

In this National Update, we're sharing the second of a series of videos about high profile issues for our Union. In this video, we speak about the protocol — collaboratively developed with the Federal Aviation Administration — for safely responding to a facility receiving news of a positive or presumed positive test. As of the week of April 27, there have been 122 confirmed positive cases, including 35 air traffic controllers, at 34 facilities. In this video, we emphasize that the goal of the protocol is to ensure all employees are safe at work and can run a safe and efficient system. NATCA and the FAA are collaborating daily to do what it takes to keep the system running safely and efficiently, while also keeping our workforce as safe as possible. This collaboration has been key to dealing with this national emergency.
