

NATCA Charitable Foundation Breaks Fundraising Records at Fort Lauderdale Convention

During the 19th Biennial Convention, the NATCA Charitable Foundation (NCF) broke their previous fundraising records and raised \$102,430. More than \$48,000 was raised through the NCF silent auction, Half Shell 5K Beach Run, Mixology experience at Stache, and Ducky Derby event. During the Convention, NATCA members also increased their bi-weekly payroll deductions by \$54,262 annually, beating the previous record of \$53,000 annual increase that was set during the 2016 NATCA Biennial Convention in San Diego. 
