



REMINDER: Tell Members of Congress They Need to Protect Retirement Benefits for Air Traffic Controllers

Forthcoming legislation is widely expected to include cuts to programs across the federal government. The Federal Employees Health Benefits Program (FEHB) and the Federal Employees Retirement System (FERS), including the supplemental annuity that applies to public safety professions including air traffic controllers, could all be targeted for cuts.
