## **ALPA President Capt. Jason Ambrosi Applauds Partnership with NATCA**

NATCA Capt. Jason Ambrosi, President of the Air Line Pilots Association, Int'l (ALPA), addressed members at NATCA's 20th Biennial Convention with a strong message of appreciation and solidarity.
