<u>FAA Reauthorization</u>: August and September plan shared with the NEB and issues raised about ensuring that the NATCA team (NEB, Staff, NLC and members) are all on board and engaged in the plan.

<u>Convention</u>: NEB review catering costs and agreed on areas to cut to save money.
